Fleetingly Known - to the music of Morning Has Broken

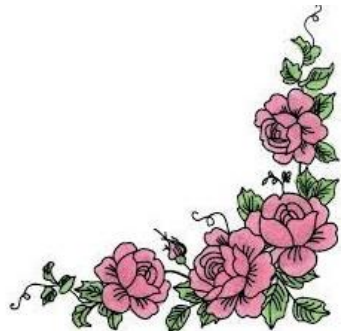
*Fleeting known, yet ever remembered
